## Harvest Festival

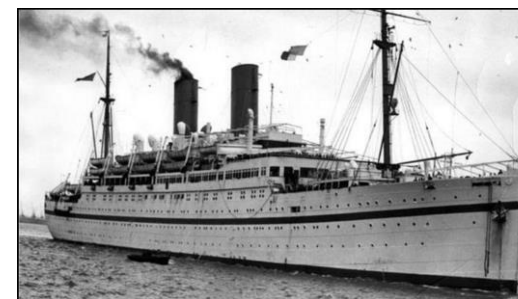


Contributions for the Harvest Festival are welcome. Please bring tinned goods, dried packaged goods into school from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> October.
