Air pollution from traffic can negatively affect children's health and impair their breathing.



- CHILL is an NHS funded study that will measure the impact of air pollution in London and Luton.
- Queen Mary University of London and CHILL will recruit children from Years 2, 3 and 4 from Vauxhall Primary School, an area with high traffic pollution.
- Your child will take part in a fun interactive learning session on air pollution and health.

They will measure your child's lung growth and health once a year for four years and measure your child's height and weight and test their lung function by blowing into a tube.
